

Equipment Requests

Instruments – General

Any good quality instruments for the BSSH general instrument and minor ops sets including:

- Fine needle holders
- Fine tenotomy scissors
- Fine bone rongeurs
- Skin hooks
- Ragnel Davis double ended retractor
- Wire cutters
- Fine pliers
- Small (Weitlander) self-retaining retractors
- Adson forceps
- Bipolar forceps and leads
- Sponge holders
- Des Marres vein retractors

Instruments - Specialist

- Skin graft knife and blades
- Micro set's
- 2 x Paediatric Hand instrument set
- Tendon weaving forceps – curved and straight
- Magnetic instrument tray inserts or silicone sterilisation tray inserts – to stop instruments being damaged in the trays
- Small instrument trays with lids 30 cm x 15-20 cm x 5-10 cm to be used for specialist instrument sets
- 3 or 4 Mitt-Matt (lead hands) or similar coated lead hands
- Sets of small fine osteotomes

Sutures

- 3-0 , 4-0 and 5-0 Prolene for tendon repairs
 - 8-0 Nylon (Ethilon)
 - 3-0 and 4-0 Monocryl or Monocryl plus
 - 3-0, 4-0, 5-0 and 6-0 vicryl rapid plus
- Please can the sutures all be in date.*
